Sub.: **Project - Panchdeep: Pehchaan**

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware that Project Panchdeep (Module Pehchan) for issue of identification cards to IPs including their family has started in the States of Delhi, Karnataka and Uttar Pradesh and distribution of cards will be commencing shortly. Once this new card is issued, it is likely that IPs may turn up to Branch Offices, Dispensaries and Hospitals etc. either with the old card or with the new card. In such case it is desirable that IP should not be denied of services irrespective of the card with which he turns up. However, where it is essential to establish the identity of the family members for their treatment, we may ask them to bring old ID Cards till complete IT roll out takes off. Suitable instructions to this effect may be issued to all the Branch Offices, IMO In-charges of Dispensaries, Medical Superintendents of the Hospital etc. within your jurisdiction.

As of now, it is a practice to hand over the new Card to IPs in a plastic cover. Now since the new identification cards will be of ATM Card size, a new plastic cover of appropriate size, with necessary guidelines in Vernacular language regarding proper handling of magnetic card may be procured well in advance so that the new ID Card is delivered in new plastic cover. Sample cover is being enclosed for ready reference.

Following guidelines (to be printed) may be got translated in Vernacular language:-

Please handle it carefully.

1. Do not fold or scratch.
2. Do not directly expose to sunlight or water.
3. Rs. 25/- will be charged for new card on loss or damage.
